

As you begin researching compelling reasons to apply to and possibly attend the University, I want to remind you about some of the benefits of a University of Virginia education:

- Personal attention from faculty with a 14 to 1 student-to-faculty ratio
- A 94% graduate rate and 97% retention rate for students
- Diverse student body with 41% of the incoming class identifying as a person of color and 15% being the first in the family to attend college
- Deep commitment to access and affordability meeting 100% of demonstrated need for all domestic applicants

Early Decision v. Early Action v. Regular Decision



| You should apply for this application deadline if | you know—without a doubt—that UVA is your top choice. Understand that if admitted during ED, you will be required to enroll at UVA unless your financial aid package doesn't provide enough to afford attending. | you want earlier notification of your admission decision but want to keep your college options open. Since EA isn't binding, you'll be able to compare offers from other schools. | you're not really interested in early notification, or you want admission officers to see the grades you've earned during the first semester of twelfth grade. |
| Application Deadline | November 1 | November 1 | January 5 |
| Financial Aid Priority Deadline | November 15 | December 1 | February 1 |
